Things You'll Need

- 1 part baking soda 1 part vinegar Old toothbrush
- 1 Pour the vinegar into a small bowl.
- 2 Add the baking soda to the vinegar and stir it quickly to form a thick paste. Never add the vinegar to the baking soda as it can cause a volcano-like effect.
- 3 Pour the paste onto the textured shower floor.
- **4** Allow the mixture to sit on the floor for 10 to 15 minutes.
- 5 Scrub the mixture into the textured floor using an old toothbrush until all the build up has been removed.
- 6 Rinse clean with warm water.
